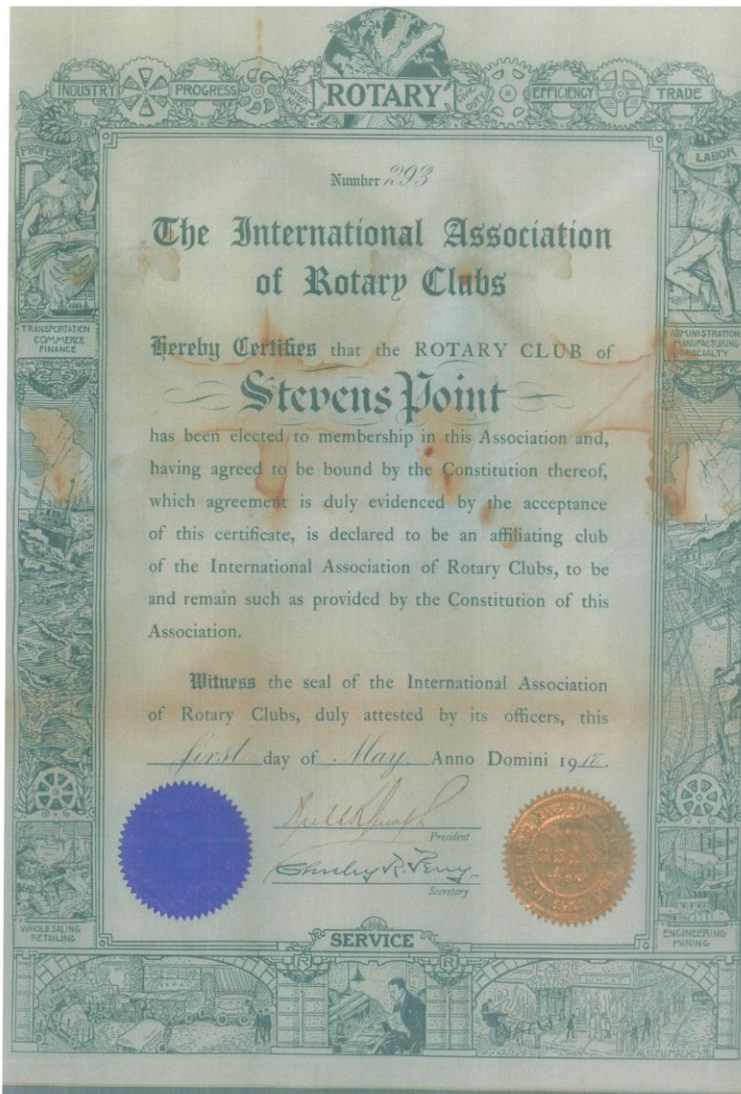


A Chronological History of Stevens Point Rotary

2-23-1905	Rotary founded by Paul Harris and three colleagues.
2-26-1917	Stevens Point Rotary holds founding meeting
3-26-1917	Stevens Point Rotary initial meeting
4-16-1917	Stevens Point Rotary holds first regular meeting
5-1-1917	Rotary International [RI] issues charter. StePt Rotary 5 th club in District [now 6220] and 193 rd of all clubs. First officers Robert Mc Donald, President; VP Judge Byron Park; Secretary L. J. Seeger [who held this position for 38-years until his death in 1955 @ age 87]; treasurer James Dunigan; and, directors P.J. Jacobs [who brought the idea from a meeting in Milwaukee, George Nelson and E.B. Robertson.
1-?-1923	Club moves permanently to new Whiting Hotel after few years at various halls, churches and clubrooms in the city.
1985-86	Club moves to Sentry World Complex; meets regularly at High Court Restaurant but sometimes moved to downstairs or over to 'The Restaurant' when High Court needed
1996 or so	Moved to Stevens Point Country Club [SPCC] where we currently meet Wednesday noon

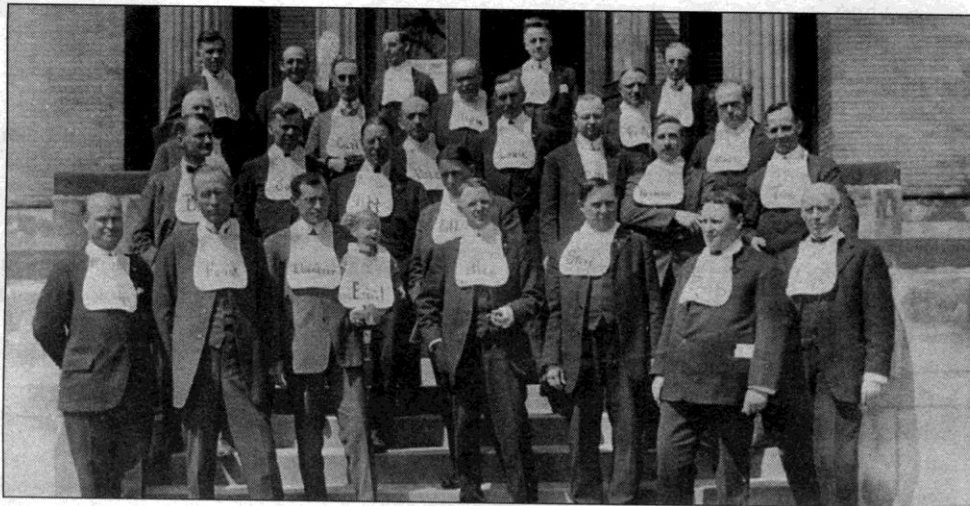
