Program –Central Wisconsin Habitat for Humanity

- Ashley Netzer introduced our main speaker Justin Rueb. Justin had been working with Central Wisconsin Habitat for Humanity for approximately 10 year. Both he and Ashley serve on the Board for the Central Wisconsin HFH. Justin works with family selection and Ashley with volunteers and communication.
- Justin explained the mission of CWHFH. It seeks to put God’s love into action by building homes, communities and hope. All Are Welcome -- CWHFH has an open-door policy: All who believe that everyone needs a decent, affordable place to live are welcome to help with the work,
- Justin briefly reviewed some of the criteria to become eligible to purchase one of CWHFH’s homes.
- Need:
 - Income between 30% and 50% of the Portage County Median Income.
 - Overcrowded living conditions.
 - Substandard living conditions.
 - Paying more than a certain percentage of monthly income for housing.
 - Justin mentioned that unfortunately there are slum lords in Stevens Point.
 - Ability to Pay:
 - to Partner:
 - Agreement to complete sweat equity requirement ,
 - Agreement to attend homeowner workshops
 - HFHCQD have completed 28 homes in the area and are working on two more.
- Justin did mention that after selection, some folks have not been able to supply the sweat equity or other criteria and had to be dropped.
