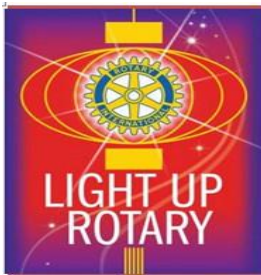
rogram – Jeff Rautio, PRIMER W.A.T.E.R. ANGLERS – Kids Fishing Day

- PWA is a not-for-profit organization, open to anyone interested in fishing.
- Kids Fishing Day is two days, normally June, with invitations to area schools, especially for kids who have never fished so they can learn.
 - First day includes classroom activities as fishing basics, fish ID, knot tying, cleaning and casting.
 - Day two utilizes volunteers with boats to give the young, generally non-anglers, their first experiences on the water. Leaving from Bukholt Park landing.
 - Snacks and many prizes are provided by local businesses.
 - Major fund raiser is hosting the Bass and Walleye Spring Classic on the WR River from Club 10, May 16-17. Company and individual donations are encouraged.

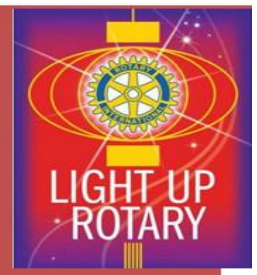
