




  - Next TriCon may be 2017,

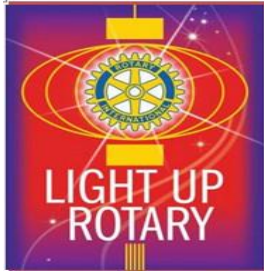

## **H**appy Dollars

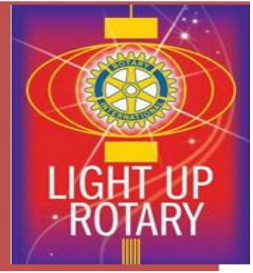
- Marcia McDonald – Attend the June 5<sup>th</sup> at StePt Airport for Veterans to fly again.

- 4 - Will it be **BENEFICIAL** to all concerned?
