



 - More than 18,000 attended this year's international conference in Sydney, Australia.

Called *Junto*, they were diverse in occupation and backgrounds, but shared a desire to improve their community and help others. Sound familiar? Author Carl Van Doren drew similarities between Paul Harris's Rotary and Franklin's *Junto*, albeit 200 years' difference.

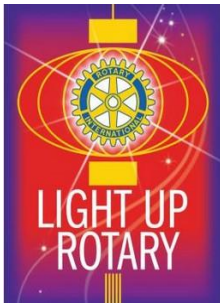

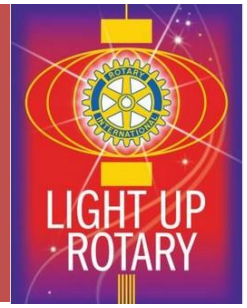
