Presenter – Kim Haas, Deputy Director, Wisconsin Judicare. Judicare has been providing legal help for eligible low income people in northern Wisconsin for over 45 years.

- WI Judicare is a non-profit law firm dedicated to providing equal access to justice in thirty-three northern Wisconsin Counties and the eleven federally recognized Indian Tribes.
- Rotarian Brad Corbett has been on the board for a long time.
- Judicare works through outreach partners and agencies in the thirty-three counties.
- The program was founded by an attorney from Madison.

- The program is designed to help eligible persons determine if they have a law suit or other legal remedy, but the program does not do criminal law for which there are other outlets.
- Most of the time and effort for lawyers is donated but funding is received through United Ways and other sources.
- Eligible persons are issued a letter of eligibility after the case is reviewed; the lawyer providing the consultation will determine if Judicare is to be involved and Judicare compensates the lawyer. There is a Helpline which is frequently useful for both client and lawyer.
- Judicare has an Indian Law Office for specific civil matters.
- Typical cases are bankruptcy, taxes, family law, health, housing, income maintenance and Indian-specific laws.
