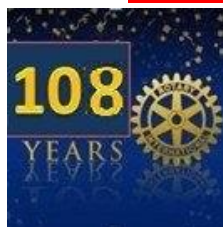

- Holiday Classic tickets still available.

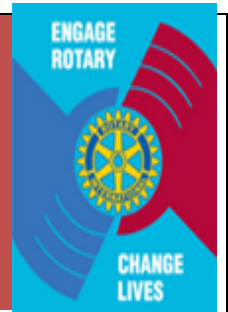
