

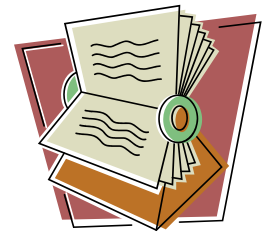

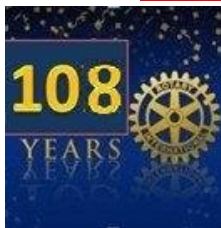


- 2014 District Conference planning time – register now; on line is available. May 1-3 at Lambeau Field, Green Bay. Register on line now and save money.

- Also presented at RCGPC – nice to get to present to both clubs.
- Flagship Pacelli has 200+ students and 810 total in all school. There has been a small decrease in enrollments at all levels for a number of years mirroring trends in all types of schools. There will be further adjustments in facilities from Central Office thru kindergartens as populations shift. Schools are offering 6-week thru High School utilizing 7 facilities.
- All the schools are active in the community. Suggest you review the attachment to the email sending this bulletin or ask for a copy if you missed it.
- Catholic Schools are celebrating Catholic Schools week right now and School Choice Jan 26-Feb 1, and the Parental Choice Program is going on right now also.
- The Sentry Technology Grant ends in 2014, provided a laptop to all students at Pacelli. In the 2014-17 grant iPads will be introduced in Middle Schools with more defined teacher training and possibility of IT in lower grades.
- Pacelli had a wonderful record: 92% of graduates continue to 2 or 4 year schools; 80% of boys and girls are involved in athletics; the J or January term has been a great success, study halls are informal, no athletic fee starting next year and students enjoy 'block' schedules.
