


- Make physical parts and designs made to customer manufacturing specifications
- Product include tooling & fixtures, special machine parts
- Prototypes and parts in development
- Industries served – medical device manufacturing, packaging and bottling, UW Research, research and product development
- Notable Changes in Industry – Computer controlled machining, machines now do repetitive work to minimize manual labor, machinist need to understand how to develop process and machine strategy using computers and other electronic tools to make it happen, computers are used for business processes, decrease lead time for

product delivery due to automation, logistics are easier to manage, faster communication with customers through Internet transactions

- **Balancing Challenges of today**– Shorter development times, doing more with same level of resources, process strategies to remain flexible.
- **Balancing Challenges of tomorrow** – finding and training employees, identifying and learning about new technologies, understand global competition, keeping current with economic changes and trends, sharing philosophy that has made the business successful.

**2 - Is it FAIR to all concerned?**

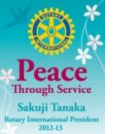
**3 - Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?**
