Presentation – Karl Franzen, Director of Workforce Development, PC Business Council, '**Leadership** Portage County – Great Learning Experience for Leaders of the Future'

- Started in 1993 and is continually evolving.
- A number of our Rotarians have been in the classes.
- Small group, one year, 10 one-day sessions to learn so much about our community and its interworkings; about 150 hours total.
- Experiential, shared experiences, learning more of the issues, adult education bringing forth new concepts and ideas, many not yet at the forefront of the general public.
- One big change is dropping the 'project' which resulted in KASH playground, skate board park, etc. Too many projects are never got far enough along to finish. Now these young and older leaders to become part of 'Community Committee' as adjunct members, e.g. on the board of the Point Dance Ensemble. All are encouraged to participate in one or more service clubs and many have joined the organization after the Leadership Institute. About 25% have remained active with the group they joined during the Institute.

- This fall's Leadership will partner with UWSP Health and Workforce organization – management class. Shared experiences for the groups are so important.
- One of the future targets is to make sure alumni stay involved. A new program with a tentative name of PC Energy will encourage involvement in programs like StePt Citizen's Police Academy, Toast Masters, the UW or MSTC board.
- Recruiting for 2011-12 class is underway. A number of scholarships will help defray some of the tuition cost of \$825.
- There have been about 500 alumni since that first class in '93. There are no fundraising or public monies in this program.
