- Raffle – AG/PP Rick Jansing the big winner but no joker for the big prize.

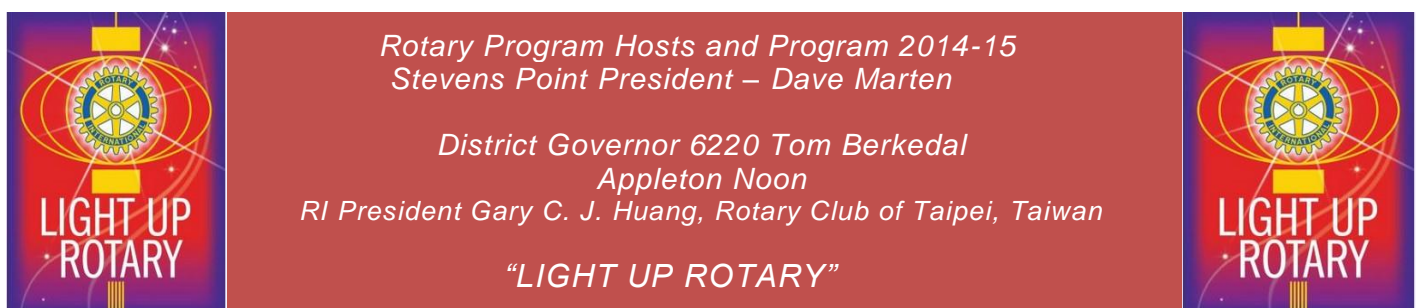
Program: Eric Olson, Dir & Lakes Outreach Specialist UW Extension Lakes Ofc; UWSP College of Natural Resources - ‘An Update on the Lakes Project’

- Fascinating updates on the lakes of Wisconsin.
- His PP presentation was forwarded for those that may have missed it.
- Hard to believe there are more than 15,000 lakes in Wisconsin
 - Most are small, 5 acres or less
 - But more than 3000 are larger than 24 acres.
- One question seems to always be raised – Minnesota’s claim of land of 10,000 lakes. Seems they just got to the tourist phrases first.
- As early as 1898 Lake Geneva started a lake area association to establish some growth controls. Today, although most lakes and waterways are state owned and/or controlled, the number of associations seeking protective rights and control have blossomed, even to small waters such as the Little Plover River.
- These associations and other groups face four major threats, issues and challenges – a never-ending struggle between tourism, economics and growth as well as control.
 - Polluted runoff
 - Aquatic invasive species – most of which are ‘imported’
 - Habitat destruction
 - Changing climate
