




- John Bergin, RYE Coordinator, still looking for an outbound candidate for 2015. Applications must be completed early this fall.
- Board Meetings moved to 3rd Monday so take note and change calendars.
- Rotary stats:
 - Members 1,220,115 in 34,558 clubs, 200+ countries and territories.
 - Rotaract: 159,401 members in 6,887 clubs, in 166 countries.
 - Interact: 385,006 members in 16,742 clubs in 161 counties.
 - More than 18,000 attended this year's international conference in Sydney, Australia.
- Ben Franklin did more than the inventions we know him for – in 1727 he got 12 friends together to debate key questions of the day. Called *Junto*, they were diverse in occupation and backgrounds, but shared a desire to improve their community and help others. Sound familiar? Author Carl Van Doren drew similarities between Paul Harris's Rotary and Franklin's *Junto*, albeit 200 years difference.
- For the Glacier Hollow challenge the morning club pulled the per capita card again and won – but all for a great cause.

Program – PP Terry Arnold, Rotary Club of Stevens Point –

- 'update on **DEFY** Program - Drug Education for Youth'
 - Developed for the Navy in 1990-91 and expanded thru the Dept of Justice to most other government agencies.
 - Targets 9-12 year olds.
 - Terry was member of team that visited major drug producing countries in Central and South America in addition to his unique experiences while with the State Department around the world. Major producers of opium/heroin are in Middle East and South America.
 - Drug producers and politics are intertwined and are the most poor countries.
 - Key markets are wealthy counties.
 - The depressing picture is 60% of US HS seniors say they have drugs at school and 50% have abused some form of drug, and that's probably understatement. More deaths from Rx drugs than cocaine & heroin.
 - The supply side – long borders, multiple delivery methods, profitable enterprise.
 - Users – wealth, social approval and pressures. Family dynamics changing and unfortunately more tolerant.
 - Check the emailed PP presentation forwarded separately or ask for it if you missed it. Very, very sobering additional information.

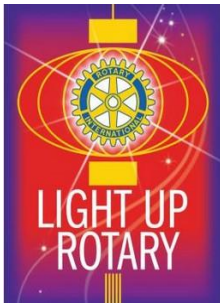

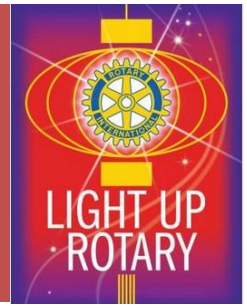
