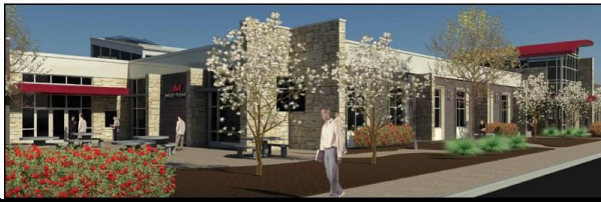

Program: Expeditionary Learning Charter School proposal for Jackson School Site.


- Al Marten, Marten Machining
- Jen Zach, for School Board member
- Dr. Connie Neegard, Ben Franklin MS.
- Goals – promote service in schools, stress youth apprenticeships, teaching kids to think.
- Current proposal is for about 100 students, volunteers selected from pool of applicants at random, grades 6-8; 9th will be a SPASH or one of the Junior HS.
- Jackson ideal since built with moveable walls and is constantly maintained.

- Supply future workers for current area businesses – close contact with area businesses and their future needs.
- Charter school will have Advisory Team with state, local and Federal funding, but the curriculum will be locally developed.
- Staff will receive special training.
- Was approved in last SB session but plan had to be re-prepared for State.
- Excellent video of similar school in Maine was shown. There are many of this type of school in the US with largest concentration on east and west coasts.
- Stevens Point already has some charter schools, even one part of SPASH, but nothing like this one.
- We can expect another report in the fall as the final plan is drawn and funding is approved.


- PE Dave Marten – glad his dad is helping with the presentation.

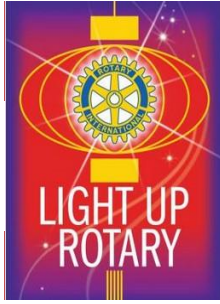

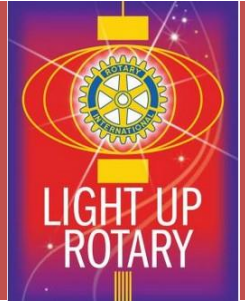
