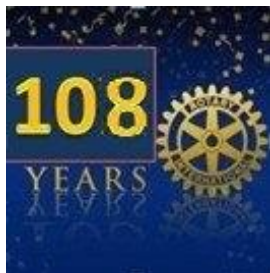

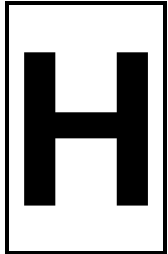
- Club Birthdays, Anniversaries

Speakers – Presented Paul Harris Fellowships to Nick Inman and Joe Leek, his 2nd.

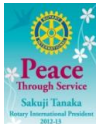
