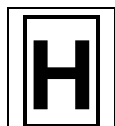

- 1 - Is it the TRUTH?
- 2 - Is it FAIR to all concerned?
- 3 - Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- 4 - Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?



Finding the Right Plant - A series of books on indigenous food plants, and the not-for-profit [Food Plants International](#), maintains a database of 25,000 edible plants that includes descriptions, lists of countries and climates where they grow, photos and drawings, and cooking methods. "There are thousands of nutritious plants, but people don't have any information about them," says an agriculturalist and member of the Rotary Club of Devonport North, Australia. "We're trying to bridge some of the gaps. "Rotarian teams in developing countries inevitably identify hunger, malnutrition, and food security as critical issues," Terry Arnold's recent conference in DC confirms this as a significant world-wide issue.
