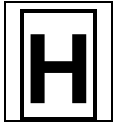

Presenter: Sara O'Donnell, PCBC Foundation and Jessica Hoerter, United Way, The Born Learning Trail

- By the time you read this the completed trail will have been dedicated [June 26th]
- The trail is a project of IGNITE, a program designed for and by young professionals in our community, formed though a partnership between the PCBC and United Way of Portage County. The group develops and encourages professional development activities, networking and community involvement. The Born Learning Trail is their major community project for the year.
- Born Learning Trail
 - Ten engaging signs to help parents and caregivers create learning opportunities for young children.
 - Each sign displays fun and interactive games promoting physical activity to exercise mind and body.
 - Suitable for 'kids' of all ages with parental/caregiver guidance.
 - The trail costs about \$6,500 with loads of volunteer work including Ellis Stone and Alchemy Concrete with County Materials, Security Fence, StePt Parks and Rec and Volm Companies contributing materials and expertise.
 - The theme of the trail is – hop, toss, shake and wiggle – to get up and move with the child.

[Finding the Right Plant](#) - A series of books on indigenous food plants, and the not-for-profit [Food Plants International](#), maintains a database of 25,000 edible plants that includes descriptions, lists of countries and climates where they grow, photos and drawings, and cooking methods. “There are thousands of nutritious plants, but people don’t have any information about them,” says an agriculturalist and member of the Rotary Club of Devonport North, Australia. “We’re trying to bridge some of the gaps. “Rotarian teams in developing countries inevitably identify hunger, malnutrition, and food security as critical issues,” Terry Arnold’s recent conference in DC confirms this as a significant world-wide issue.

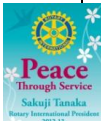

On to Lisbon

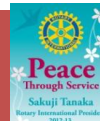
