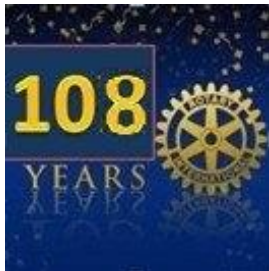

## **A**nnouncements

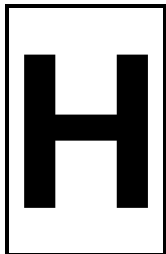

## **Speakers - Toastmasters**

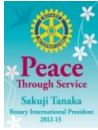
- Three clubs in Portage County, one in WR and Waupaca, two in Wausau

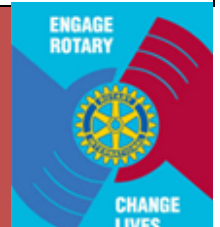
