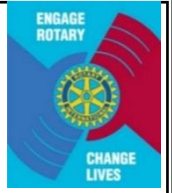

 - Ann Huntoon – District Service award

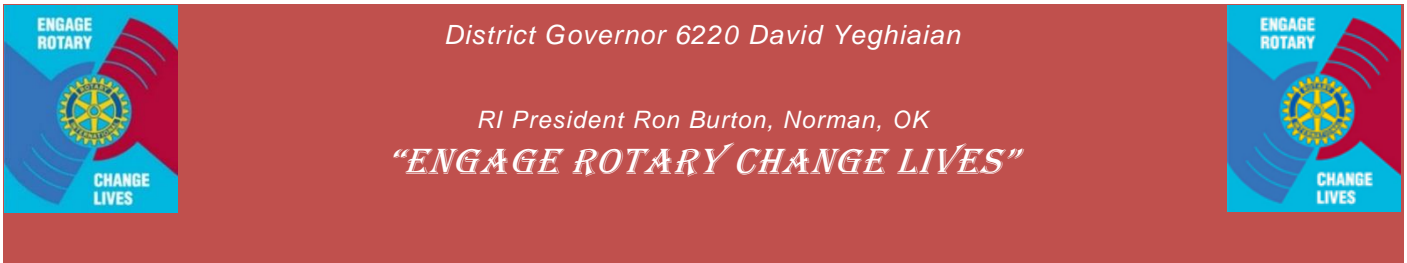


- Ann Huntoon: AG Rick Jansing (for lending a Rotary pin at the conference).


