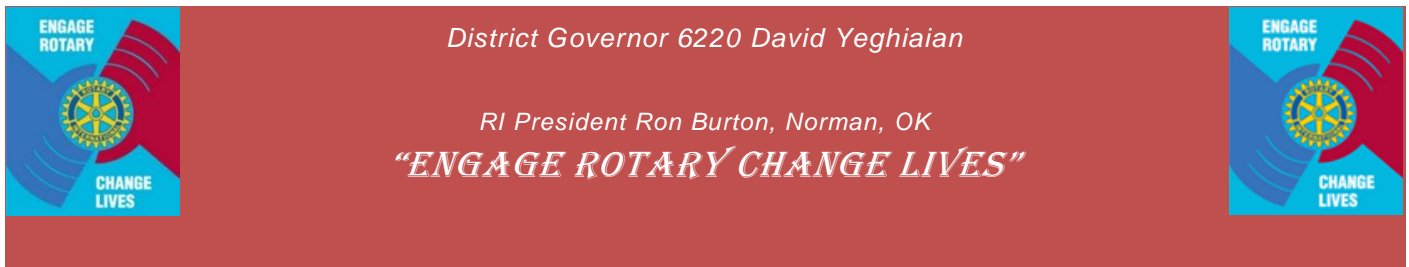
Program: Dr. Fred Eichmiller, VP/Science Officer for Delta Dental of WI, “The Science behind Delta”

- Suspect few in our community realize the major projects to which Delta provides leadership and/or are actively engaged in the research.



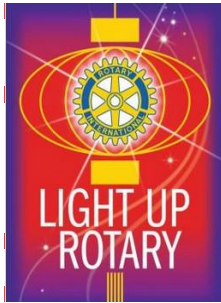
Happy Dollars

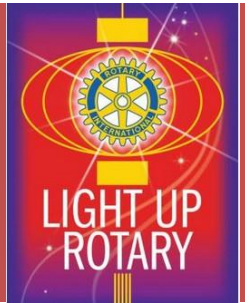

- 1 - Is it the TRUTH?**
- 2 - Is it FAIR to all concerned?**
- 3 - Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?**
- 4 - Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?**
