This type of program is being extended internationally through controlled franchising. Their employees are trained, screened and bonded. Matching with the client is important. Surprisingly, most of the employees themselves are over 60, healthy and are great at providing to needy seniors. Users are generally charged on hourly basis and some long-term care insurance covers expenses, but generally not Medicare. Clients must be in their own homes.
