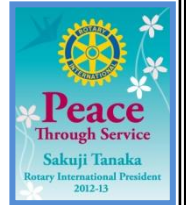

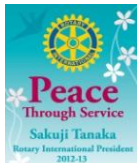
Presenters: INTERACT, ROTARACT, RYE and RYLA reports

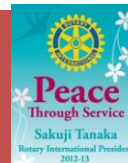
Happy Dollars
