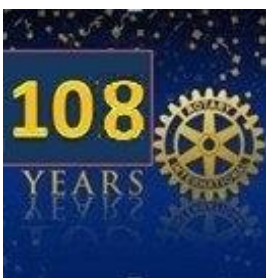

- Gary's team was from the Tennessee Guard. His own ROTC students were on other teams. There are many CULP locations around the world.

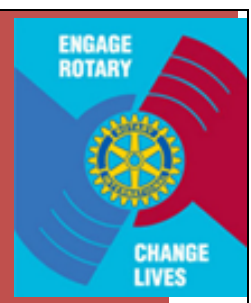
