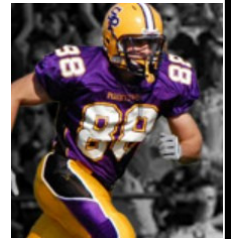

Deb Freeberg came attired in the latest ‘t-shirt’ fashion with the Rotary emblem, taking orders for those that want one. The Saturday of the sale will be Bev’s Floral 10th anniversary which coincides nicely, a fabulous joint celebration, the 24th year of the Rotary Rose Sale and Bev’s first decade. Many more details including posters, order blanks, etc. will be forthcoming in the next couple of weeks.

Presenter Plover Village Exec Dan Mahoney with a great update.

- Now more than a decade as senior village administrator.
- JD Manville noted that his hobby shop has to move again – lots of street widening in Plover in the next few years.
- Springville Pond will have a small draw down to accomplish minor repairs.
- \$1 from Dan for seeing Chancellor riding his bike in the neighborhood but looked like he could have used training wheels.
- Last 10 years Plover has added \$125M in assessed value to now total about \$1B.
- Moved – a number of businesses are moving around, e.g. Tempura House from Post to B and larger facility; O’so Brew House into Plover Village area taking almost all the remaining space on the west complex.
- WI Rural Water Corp. making a \$1M expansion for expanded training facility.
- Senior complex near St. Brons continues to expand and be occupied as new housing added.
- Crossroads – more new retail, e.g. Jo-Ann Fabric and some yet to be named; PetCo & Michaels area growing.
- Expansion well ahead of 2010
- Pulling for Skyward to win that WI contract and continue their growth.
- Special \$1 for the 9-11 memorial celebrations to be held at the Plover fire/police station.
- Budget at least a two year challenge like all municipalities.
- Lots of road projects, new interchanges, boulevards, etc.
- Special Celebrate Plover event July 28, 2012 in Lake Pacawa area.

- Terry Arnold kicked off the Happy Dollar collection with a buck for a great sunny day and they are numbered according to the weather prognosticators.
